


## 2019 Dixie Fellowship

## Order of the Arrow PhilBreak 2019

Philmont and the Order of the Arrow are excited to offer OA PhilBreak 2019. This event will consist of a full week preparing Philmont for the 2019 camping season. Following the fires of 2018, Philmont needs our help to accommodate campers once again. Actual work will include slope stabilization projects, such as log erosion barrier and wattle installation, as well as re-vegetation, campsite installation, and forest thinning. Only 50 slots will be open for each session, filled in the order that registrations are received. There are three sessions available: March 16-23, March 23-30, and March 30-April 6. The cost is only \$100; note, this does not include travel arrangements. The registration deadline is February 15th, 2019. Participants are required to be registered with the BSA and a member of the Order of the Arrow. This program is available to Order of the Arrow members 16 years old and above. The full Philmont medical form with your doctor's approval is required.
